Abstract Submission: (**Submission Deadline: September 12, 2004**)

Everyone who submits a paper or poster must submit an abstract of no more than 250 words, using the format explained below.

- For author, affiliation, and title, please follow the appropriate sample below.
- The first line of text should follow directly underneath the title and should be indented one tab stop. Text should be single-spaced.
- In the line below the text, indent one tab stop and type 'keywords:' followed by up to three keywords, separated by a comma and ending with a period.
- Do not insert any codes for justification, hyphenation, line height, line centering, margins, spacing, fonts, page centering, page numbering, suppression, or tabs.
- Please note that abstracts will not be edited.

Please name your file using the first eight letters of the presenter's last name as the file name and the first three letters of the first name as the extension. Submit your abstract, preferably by e-mail (or alternatively by mail), as a Microsoft Word 2000 or WordPerfect 7 or 8 file:
